







Appealing a decision that you don't agree with in an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)

Step 1 Ask for help

You can speak with your school/ college SENCO to support you if you do not agree with something in the Plan. You can get in touch with **SENDIASS Leicester** for help.



Step 2 Ask for changes

You can tell the Local Authority that you are not happy with a decision or make a complaint. SENDIASS can help you with this.

Global Med/ation



Step 3 Mediation

You can get in touch with Global Mediation and ask for a meeting with everybody involved. The service is free and confidential and is a good way of making **your voice** heard to everyone involved. You can choose whether to use this or not.

Support to Appeal



Step 4 Appeal the Decision
You can appeal against many different things like what is written or not written in the plan, the
type of school/ college it says or when information is incorrect.
The Tribunal will make a decision.



This might take a while and it's not a quick process. You can ask **SENDIASS Leicester** to help you.
